The Joy Church Growth Track is a journey of clear steps to discover your redemptive purpose and to live the life God created for you. The Growth Track is made up of four steps that equip you to become a member, discover your design, develop your leadership and join the dream team.

stepONE - Become a Member

Explore the ministry of Joy Church Medford and find out how to get connected with our church. Step One happens the first Sunday of every month.

stepTWO - Discover Your Design

Dive into the details of your personality, discover your God given gifts, and see how your design reveals your purpose in life and your best fit in ministry.

Step Two happens the second Sunday of every month.

stepTHREE - Develop Your Leadership

Find out what it means to be a servant leader at Joy Church and learn how you can strengthen your character and gifting to fulfill your leadership potential.

Step Three happens the third Sunday of every month.

stepFOUR - Join the Dream Team

Connect to the opportunities available at Joy to live out your purpose and serve others by using your God-given gifts.

Step Four happens on the fourth Sunday of every month.

THE JOY CHURCH STORY

Pastor Steve and Kim Schmelzer planted Joy on August 15,1982. Their passion was to build a strong church family committed to bringing people to a relationship with Jesus and leading them to a life of obedience to God. The journey began with one other family in a small storefront in Medford, Oregon. Along with their 4 kids and a Dream Team of great people the church has grown into a thriving community serving Medford and the surrounding areas. What started as one church has grown into more Joy Churches working to make Jesus famous.

Joy is a great community to be a part of. Regardless of your season of life there is a place for you to be connected and involved. One of Pastor Steve's favorite quotes is from the shorter Westminster catechism, "The chief end of man is to glorify God and to enjoy Him forever." That is why everything we do is intentional

to bring glory to God and to do it with joy! How do we accomplish this - through Faith, Family and Fun.

- Faith: Joy Church is a family where you can discover and grow in your faith in God and learn how to build a life that fulfills God's purpose for you in His kingdom. We love God's Word and believe it the only foundation to build your faith on.
- Family: Joy Church is a family of families built up of people from all walks and seasons of life. Our goal is to grow together and reach our world with the Good News of Jesus Christ. We love families and believe that they are the building blocks of society. We want each family to be strong and stable and to be a part of the greater Joy family and family of God.
- **Fun**: Joy Church is a family that knows how to have fun doing life together. Through connect groups, events and building relationships we experience the joy of life. We are better together.

We want to make sure you understand what it means to be a Christian, have been baptized in water and have the tools to know God personally and to grow in your faith.

HOW CONNECT GROUPS WORK:

A Connect Group is an intentional gathering of people who meet regularly. Since God designed us for relationships, we believe it is through the connections made in small groups that God will help us grow. People form groups around what matters in their lives. This can look like people connecting with people from their same stage of life or with people who have experience in an area in which you want to grow. Connect Groups are also where we pray for each other and support each other. Connect Groups meet every week during the Connect Semester in locations all around our city and with many groups to choose from we believe there is a group out there for you.

Four things you should know about Connect Groups:

1. We have a variety of Connect Groups to choose from.

We have men and women's groups, youth and young adult groups and children's groups. We have specialty groups focused on helping you in your marriage, with finances, parenting, finding freedom and Solid Rock Road groups for freedom from unhealthy habits and addictions. You can join more than one group. Some groups stay together for a long time and others are for a specific period of time.

2. We meet at different times and locations.

Groups meet every week during the Connect Group semester but vary in day, time and location. We have

groups starting every semester so you are sure to find one that fits your needs. We have three group semesters:

- Fall Semester: This semester starts in September and runs for 12 weeks.
- Winter/Spring Semester: This semester starts in February and runs for 12 weeks.
- Summer Semester: This semester starts in June and runs for 6 8 weeks.

3. You can join a Connect Group.

We would love for you to join a connect group. To find the right group for you simply visit www.joymedford.com to search our online directory of groups, or call or visit our church office or Connect Center. Feel free to contact the leader to learn more and to make plans to visit in person.

4. You can host a Connect Group.

We believe everyone has areas of strength and gifting that can benefit others and hosting a small group is a great way to make meaningful connections. The first step toward becoming a small group leader is to attend the small group leader training at step four of the growth track. These classes are offered regularly throughout the year to give you an overview of how simple it is to start a group. You will discover that it is easier than you think.

3. DISCOVER PURPOSE

The Joy Church Growth Track offers information and experiences designed to help you grow in your faith and discover and develop your redemptive purpose and live the full life God wants for you. Our process is made up of four steps, which guide you to connect to God, connect to the church, grow and discover your purpose and go and serve others.

1. StepONE - ______ Become a Member

This step is a basic introduction to the ministry of Joy Church and offers you the opportunity to become a part of our church family by becoming a member and joining a connect group. StepONE happens the first Sunday of every month.

2. StepTWO - _____ Discover Your Design

This step helps you grow as you discover your unique personality and gifts, which point you to your purpose

in life. StepTWO happens the second Sunday of every month.

3. StepTHREE - _____ Develop Your Leadership

This step helps you discover what it means to be a Dream Team member at Joy Church and learn how you can strengthen your character and gifting to fulfill your leadership potential. StepTHREE happens the third Sunday of every month.

4. StepFOUR - _____ Join the Dream Team

This step offers you the opportunity to get going and become a part of the Dream Team by connecting with the serve team of your choice and learning how you can serve others by using your gifts and living out your purpose. StepFOUR happens the fourth Sunday of every month.

The big-picture of the Growth Track is to LIVE FOR CHRIST/SERVE OTHERS. At Joy Church, we practice tithing for the support of Christ's Body, the church, as God commands. We recognize that giving 10% of our income is the Biblical standard for giving.

Many people love to give to God but need to have confidence in the methods and purposes used by organizations to which they give. Therefore, there are a great number of people willing to give if they are able to see honesty, integrity and genuine spiritual values reflected in the lifestyles of the church leaders.

At Joy Church we believe that:

STATEMENT OF FAITH

HOLY BIBLE

The Holy Bible, and only the Bible, is the authoritative Word of God. It alone is the final authority in determining all doctrinal truths. In its original writing, it is inspired, infallible and inerrant.

TRINITY

There is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. These three are coequal and co-eternal.

JESUS CHRIST

Jesus Christ is God the Son, the second person of the Trinity. On earth, Jesus was 100% God and 100% man. He is the only man ever to have lived a sinless life. He was born of a virgin, performed miracles, died on the cross for mankind and thus, atoned for our sins through the shedding of His blood. He rose from the dead on the third day according to the Scriptures, ascended to the right hand of the Father, and will return again in power and glory.

VIRGIN BIRTH

Jesus Christ was conceived by God the Father, through the Holy Spirit (the third person of the Trinity) in the virgin Mary's womb; therefore, He is the Son of God.

REDEMPTION

Man was created good and upright, but by voluntary transgression he fell; his only hope of redemption is in Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

For anyone to know God, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential.

SALVATION

We are saved by grace through faith in Jesus Christ: His death, burial, and resurrection. Salvation is a gift from God, not a result of our good works or of any human efforts.

REPENTANCE

Repentance is the commitment to turn away from sin in every area of our lives and to follow Christ, which allows us to receive His redemption and to be regenerated by the Holy Spirit. Thus, through repentance we receive forgiveness of sins and appropriate salvation.

SANCTIFICATION

Sanctification is the ongoing process of yielding to God's Word and His Spirit in order to complete the development of Christ's character in us. It is through the present ministry of the Holy Spirit and the Word of God that the Christian is enabled to live a Godly life.

Marriage:

We believe marriage is defined in the Bible as a covenant, a sacred bond between one man and one woman, instituted by and publicly entered into before God.

HEALING OF THE SICK

Healing of the sick is illustrated in the life and ministry of Jesus, and included in the commission of Jesus to His disciples. It is given as a sign, which is to follow believers. It is also a part of Jesus' work on the Cross and one of the gifts of the Spirit.
